The Academic Dean's Office (PROACAD), through the Research and Post-Graduation Board, announces that applications are open for the selection process and admission of Foreigners to Post-Graduation Programs (Stricto Sensu) in Law, Public Health and Productive Systems at Master level, and in Environmental Sciences, Health Sciences, Materials Science and Engineering, Socioeconomic Development and Education at Master and Doctoral levels.

2 – ABOUT THE FOREIGN SELECTION PROCESS

2.1 The Foreign Selection Process for admission to the Post-Graduation Programs presented in this public notice in the **year 2022** will comply with the terms and conditions of this public notice.

2.2 The present Foreign Selection Process is aimed at foreigners who do not live in Brazil and who have an undergraduate degree certificate or equivalent.

3. ABOUT APPLICATIONS

3.1 Applications will be carried out in a steady flow during the **year 2022**, through the link Master's candidate application, or doctoral candidate application.

3.2 To apply for the selection process for one of the **Post-Graduation Programs at MASTER level**, the candidate must correctly fill in the form and upload the pdf file containing the following documents:

a) Fill in and send the application form, indicating the probable advisor, according to the list available at www.unesc.net/ppgcm (Materials Science and Engineering); www.ppgca.unesc.net (Environmental Sciences); www.ppgcs.unesc.net (Health Sciences); www.unesc.net/ppgds (Socioeconomic Development); www.unesc.net/ppqd (Law); www.unesc.net/ppge (Education); and www.ppgsp.net (Productive Systems);

b) Passport;

c) Undergraduate degree certificate or equivalent authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued;

- d) Sworn translation of the undergraduate degree certificate or equivalent authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued, not necessary for documents written in a Latin language;
- e) Undergraduate Course (or equivalent) Academic Transcript authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued;
- f) Sworn translation of the Undergraduate Course Academic Transcript, not necessary for documents written in a Latin language;
- g) Curriculum of official public platform of the country of origin;
- h) Descriptive Memorial – ATTACHMENT I;
- i) Declaration of residence – ATTACHMENT III.

3.2.1 Specifically for the Post-Graduation Program in Law (PPGD), an Undergraduate Degree Certificate in Law is required.

3.2.2 The Curriculum of official public platform of the country of origin as well as the Descriptive Memorial must be in Portuguese.

3.3 To apply for the selection process for one of the **Post-Graduation Programs at DOCTORATE level**, the candidate must correctly fill in the form and upload the pdf file containing the following documents:

- a) Fill in and send the application form available at www.unesc.net/ppgcm (Materials Science and Engineering); www.ppgca.unesc.net (Environmental Sciences); www.ppgcs.unesc.net (Health Sciences); www.unesc.net/ppgds (Socioeconomic Development); and www.unesc.net/ppge (Education), indicating the probable advisor;
- b) Passport;
- c) Undergraduate degree certificate or equivalent authenticated by the Embassy of the country of origin;
- d) Sworn translation of the undergraduate degree certificate or equivalent authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued, not necessary for documents written in a Latin language;
- e) Undergraduate Course (or equivalent) Academic Transcript authenticated by the Embassy of the country of origin;
- f) Sworn translation of the Undergraduate Course Academic Transcript, not necessary for documents written in a Latin language;
- g) Master's Degree Certificate or equivalent authenticated by the Embassy of the country of origin;
- h) Sworn translation of the Master's Degree Certificate or equivalent authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued, not necessary for documents written in a Latin language;
- i) Master's (or equivalent) Academic Transcript authenticated by the Embassy of the country of origin;
- j) Sworn translation of the Master's Degree Academic Transcript, not necessary for documents written in a Latin language;
- k) Curriculum of official public platform of the country of origin;
- l) Memorial – ATTACHMENT II;
- m) Declaration of residence – ATTACHMENT III.

3.3.1 The Curriculum of official public platform of the country of origin as well as the Memorial must be in Portuguese.

3.3.2 Those candidates for the Doctorate in Health Sciences who prove to have 05 (five) or more articles, published or accepted for publication, in journals indexed by the ISI (Institute of Scientific Information), which have an impact factor greater than 1.0 (one) do not need to have a Master's Degree.

3.4 UNESCO is not responsible for failures in the data transmission process for applications, so the applicants must contact the university to confirm receipt of the application form and the requested documents.

4. ABOUT THE APPROVAL OF APPLICATIONS

4.1 The application approval will be communicated to the applicant via email within a maximum period of 5 (five) days from the receipt of the application.

4.2 Only applications in which all the requirements listed in items 3.2 and 3.3 of this Notice are strictly complied with will be approved.

5. ABOUT THE SELECTION PROCESS

5.1 About the Descriptive Memorial

5.1.1 The descriptive memorial must be constructed according to the items requested in ATTACHMENT I or II of this public notice.

5.1.2 The descriptive memorial must be carried out in Portuguese, English or Spanish, except for PPGE applicants, whose descriptive memorial should be exclusively in Portuguese.

5.1.3 The project will be evaluated by the respective Coordinating Board of the Post-Graduation Program.

5.1.4 A grade from 0.0 (zero) to 10.0 (ten) will be assigned to the descriptive memorial.

5.1.5 Applicants must get a minimum grade of 5.0 (five) to pass this stage.

5.2 About the Interview

5.2.1 The interview will be conducted in Portuguese, English or Spanish, except for PPGE applicants who will be interviewed exclusively in Portuguese and for PPGCS applicants who will be interviewed in Portuguese or English.

5.2.2 Applicants will be interviewed individually by a board made up of members of the respective Post-Graduation Program, via Google Meet, focusing on the curriculum and on the research proposal, getting a grade which may vary from 0.0 (zero) to 10.0 (ten).

5.2.3 To pass the interview, applicants must get a minimum grade of 7.0 (seven).

5.2.4 Interview dates will be communicated to applicants at least 24 hours in advance.

5.2.5 During the interview, applicants must make a brief presentation of their research proposal, as well as answer questions asked by the members of the board.

5.2.6 The candidate must use the data transmission method to be indicated by the Universidade do Extremo Sul Catarinense – UNESC, as well as having access to the internet which makes the interview possible, under penalty of being disqualified.

5.2.6.1 In exceptional cases, in which applicants need to carry out a face-to-face interview, a written and reasoned request must be sent to the committee.

5.3 About Final Results

5.3.1 The final result of the selection process will be obtained by the weighted average of the grades obtained in the Descriptive Memorial, 4 (four), and in the Interview, 6 (six).

5.3.2 Applicants' classification will be formally communicated via e-mail.

5.3.3 Candidates who are not approved will only be able to submit an application for the selection process again after a period of 6 (six) months since the last participation.

6. ABOUT ENROLLMENT, INVESTMENT AND ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

6.1 Before enrollment, applicants must go to the International Relations Office (Escritório de Relações Internacionais) to check the necessary documents, according to item 6.5 of this Notice, as well as to receive guidance to regularize their stay in Brazil.

6.2 The lack of any document established in item 6.5 of this notice, will result in the impediment to the enrollment.

6.3 Approved applicants must enroll in the course at the Secretariat of the respective Post-Graduation Program located on the UNESCO campus, according to the deadline indicated to applicants directly by e-mail.

6.4 Enrollment in the course will imply the payment of the corresponding amounts as informed via email, being the first installment due upon enrollment and the others, on the 10th of the following months.

6.5 At the time of enrollment, the following documents must be presented:

- b) Passport with suitable visa for studies;
- c) Readable photocopy of the Birth or Marriage Certificate;

- e) Authenticated photocopy of the sworn translation of the original Undergraduate Degree Certificate authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued, not necessary for documents written in a Latin language;
- f) Original Undergraduate Course Academic Transcript authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued and a photocopy authenticated at a notary's office in Brazil;
- g) Authenticated photocopy of the sworn translation of the original Undergraduate Course Academic Transcript authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued, not necessary for documents written in a Latin language.

6.5.2 FOR THE DOCTORATE

- a) Proof of presentation at the International Relations Office;
- b) Passport with suitable visa for studies;
- c) Readable photocopy of the Birth or Marriage Certificate;
- d) Original Undergraduate Degree Certificate authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued and a photocopy authenticated at a notary's office in Brazil;
- e) Authenticated photocopy of the sworn translation of the original Undergraduate Degree Certificate authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued, not necessary for documents written in a Latin language;
- f) Original Undergraduate Course Academic Transcript authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued and a photocopy authenticated at a notary's office in Brazil;
- g) Authenticated photocopy of the sworn translation of the original Undergraduate Course Academic Transcript authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued, not necessary for documents written in a Latin language.
- h) Original Master's Degree Certificate authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued and a photocopy authenticated at a notary's office in Brazil;

- i) Authenticated photocopy of the sworn translation of the original Master's Degree Certificate authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued, not necessary for documents written in a Latin language;
- j) Original Master's Academic Transcript authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued and a photocopy authenticated at a notary's office in Brazil;
- k) Authenticated photocopy of the sworn translation of the original Master's Academic Transcript authenticated by the Embassy of Brazil in the country where the document was issued, not necessary for documents written in a Latin language.

6.6 Graduation certificates or equivalent must be recognized in the country of origin, respecting international agreements of reciprocity or equivalence, under penalty of withdrawal from the program.

6.7 Exclusively for admission to the course for which they were selected, foreign applicants will have their certificates validated for this purpose by the Program Coordinating Board, not granting national validity to the title for any other purpose.

6.8 Academic activities will start according to the students' entry calendar of each Post-Graduation Program participating in this Public Notice.
